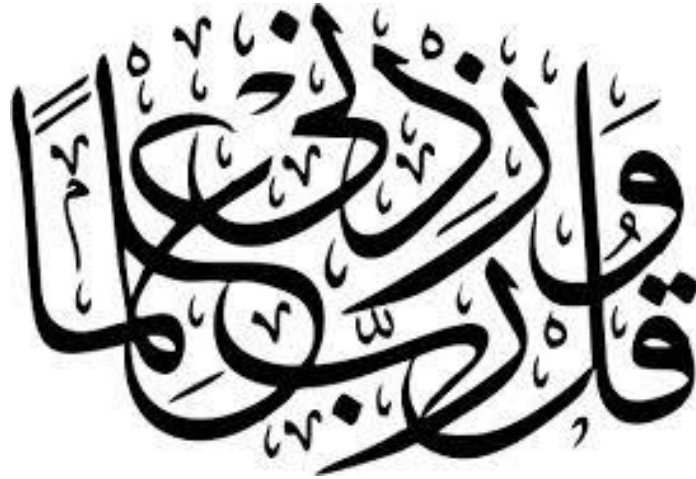

## **COLLEGE HISTORY & INTRODUCTION**

Khairpur Tamewali was an oldest town of Bahawalpur State. It remained center of different administrative activities of State Bahawalpur. It saw many ups and downs and now it is a distant Tehsil of Bahawalpur District. The origin of this city has been found even before Islam came in the valley of Sindh. This city used to be situated on the shore of Ghaghra river (Sutlej). The thunderous waves of the Sutlej River destroyed the city many times. Once in the history, this city also faced the wrath of Nadir Shah. These were the days when the town of Khairpur Tamewali was the center of a tiny state. The state of Bahawalpur consisted of six districts: Sadiqabad, Allahbad, Dera Nawab, Bahawalpur city, Khairpur Tamewali and Minchanabad. The territory of that time district Khairpur Tamewali spread from Bahawalpur to Bahawalnagr. After the completion of Sutlej-Dehli Project in 1925, new cities and markets came into being within the state. With the establishment of *Mandis* (markets) in Chishtian and Hasilpur, these cities started progressing rapidly and Khairpur Tamewali gradually began to lose its status and it fell under the jurisdiction of Hasilpur. Afterwards, Hasilpur developed and became a separate Tehsil Headquarter. The town of Khairpur Tamewali which once used to be the center of the district turned into just a Sub-Tehsil.

With the development of the city, the educational needs of the native people began to increase and this led them to struggle for a Higher Educational Institute for the female of this area. At last their efforts bore fruit and to meet the increasing educational needs of the Tehsil and understanding the importance of female education, the Punjab Government established this college on Inter level in 01-09-1999 on the request of local residents and District Government. It started its working in the borrowed building of Civil Hospital Khairpur Tamewali. By the Grace of Allah Almighty and with the untiring efforts of the Principal, Teaching & the Administrative staff, the college has acquired the status of Graduate College and now it has its own building spanning over 72 canals, having 14 classrooms, 5 laboratories, multi-purpose hall,

library block, canteen, administrative block and residential block for the staff. Moreover, the constant efforts of the college Principal and staff resulted in the approval of an additional admin block and an auditorium of which construction will start soon. The main road in front of college building is rebuilt and a 1600 feet water furrow had already installed.

Despite the lack of resources, this institution is progressing very well. The college results always remained above board and university. From 2011, college got three positions in the board and university. Now college has started ADP and got approval of BS English Programme. With meager facilities, the college keeps on its journey of success and the whole staff is working whole heartedly to quench the thirst of knowledge among the students. We are resolute to continue this journey of success in future as well. Associate Degree Programme (ADP) has been started in the year 2020 and by the grace of Allah it has been successful. BS English is going to start year 2021 and work is also in progress for the approval of BS in other subjects.

Govt. Graduate College has distinction to be declared as **Well Managed** institute in term of security by the security officer of the Home Department Government of the Punjab and the local government. It is further honored to be recognized as satisfactory and commendable institution by the inspection team of The Islamia University of Bahawalpur. All this becomes possible due to the efforts and cooperation of gazetted, non-gazetted and other staff of staff of the college.

The college is also indebted to the conveners of the Clean and Green Pakistan **Mr. Muhammad Iqbal Baibris** and **Mr. WaqarYaqoob** who provided 400clay trolleys to fill the land for the land filling in front of college main gate, thereby play their role to realize Prime Minter's Vision of Clean and Green Pakistan. The college also owe very much to **Respected Professor Abdul Hameed Ahmad** who has helped in the approval of BS Programs, college admin block auditorium. He also donated round about Three hundred of books for the college library and several fruitful plants and shady trees. He has been

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ADMISSION:**

1. For securing admission in pre medical, non-medical and general science groups, applicants with first division and matric with science are eligible to apply. Candidates have to apply online on [www.ocas.punjab.gov.pk](http://www.ocas.punjab.gov.pk) . Strict merit policy is followed.
2. Students can apply for re-admission only for one time; those who failed in 1<sup>st</sup> year can take readmission in the same group. The Candidates who have passed either 1<sup>st</sup> year or 2<sup>nd</sup> year from any board of Punjab are not eligible for readmission. They have to submit affidavit in this regard.
3. Admission of 1<sup>st</sup> year, ADP and BS classes will be started after the announcement of results. After passing matriculation, the applicants can get admission in the college within five years as per direction of the Government of Punjab.
4. The applicants have to submit character certificate obtained from their previous institution. In case of private candidates, their character certificates can be signed by any teacher government teacher.
5. Students have to submit NOC if they have taken exam under any board other than BISE Bahawalpur and for ADP & BS, they have to obtain NOC from the concerned university.
6. For admission in 1<sup>st</sup> year age limit is 18 and for ADP & BS is 20. Two year relaxation can be granted with special permission of the principal.
7. Special quota seats are reserved only in Arts group.
8. Original documents should be provided by the applicants at the time of admission. Failing to provide documents will result in cancellation of admission.
9. Four photocopies of required documents should be provided along with admission form.
  - Four photocopies of result card.
  - Four photocopies of character certificate.
  - Four photocopies NOC from the concerned board.
  - Four photocopies of father's CNIC.
  - Four photocopies of domicile.
  - Four photocopies of B-Form/ CNIC.
  - Four photocopies of special person certificate.
  - Four fresh passport size pictures.

10. In case of father's death or being out of country, her mother or elder brother will be considered her guardian.
11. The applicants must ensure attendance at the time of interview or test otherwise their admission will be rejected.
12. Only those students can secure admission in the college who pay their fee within due date.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

1. Students have to ensure 75% of attendance during academic session to be allowed to appear in board/university exams. Attendance will be counted from the beginning of academic session till 15 days before exams.
2. Late comers will be considered absent.
3. In case of unavoidable circumstances, students will be responsible to complete 75% of attendance.
4. Students have to submit leave application in advance which will be signed by student's father and then class incharge.
5. In case of leave for more than five days, medical certificate of govt. hospital must be submitted.
6. Name will be struck off in case of continuous absentees for 10days.
7. Fine for readmission is 150/- with affidavit.
8. The admission will be cancelled in case of failure to pay dues within due date.
9. Fine for one day absentee is one rupees.
10. Attendance in Send-ups exams is mandatory otherwise students' board admission can be detained.

### **PAYMENT OF FEE AND FINE:**

1. The students will get a payment receipt.
2. The due date can be extended with special permission of the principal.

### **LIBRARY SECURITY FEE:**

Library Security fee will be returned to the students. The students have to submit application form. After one year the security cannot be claimed.

## **SCHOLARSHIPS:**

- PEEF Scholarship (merit base), Rehmatul-lil-Alamin (merit base,needbase) and Ehsas Scholarship(for all needy students) scholarships are offered on merit basis
- The poor students are given fee concession on quota basis.

**Note: students involve in any illegal and immoral activities are not eligible for these scholarship programmes.**

## **COLLEGE ID CARD:**

The college issues ID Card to the students. Students have to keep the card with them every time otherwise they will be fined. In case of loss of ID Card, 100/- will be charged for the re-issuance.

## **COLLEGE UNIFORM:**

- The color of uniform is White. Pajamas or trousers of any kind of design are not allowed. Short shirts are also prohibited in the college.
- Artificial or gold jewelry is not allowed. Hair accessories must be of black color only.
- In winter season, only black jersey and black shawls are allowed.
- Only black shoes are allowed. Sandals and Heels are forbidden.

### **ASSOCIATE DEGREE PROGRAMME (ADP):**

Associate Degree Programme (ADP) is a two-year post-intermediate academic degree to be awarded by public & private Universities. The concept behind introducing the associate degree program is to offer a skilled based degree. ADP is offered primarily in market driven subjects based on local and regional community and industry needs to be determined through a comprehensive survey to be carried out by the University/Institution concerned.

### **STATUS AND SCOPE OF ASSOCIATE DEGREE PROGRAMME (ADP):**

The Associate Degree Programme (ADP) is equivalent to BA/BSc Degree. An Associate Degree programme is normally structured to be conducted over four regular semesters over a two-year period and consists of 65-68 credit hours. An Associate Degree Holder is eligible to get admission in the 5<sup>th</sup> semester of BS programmes in any HEC recognized universities.

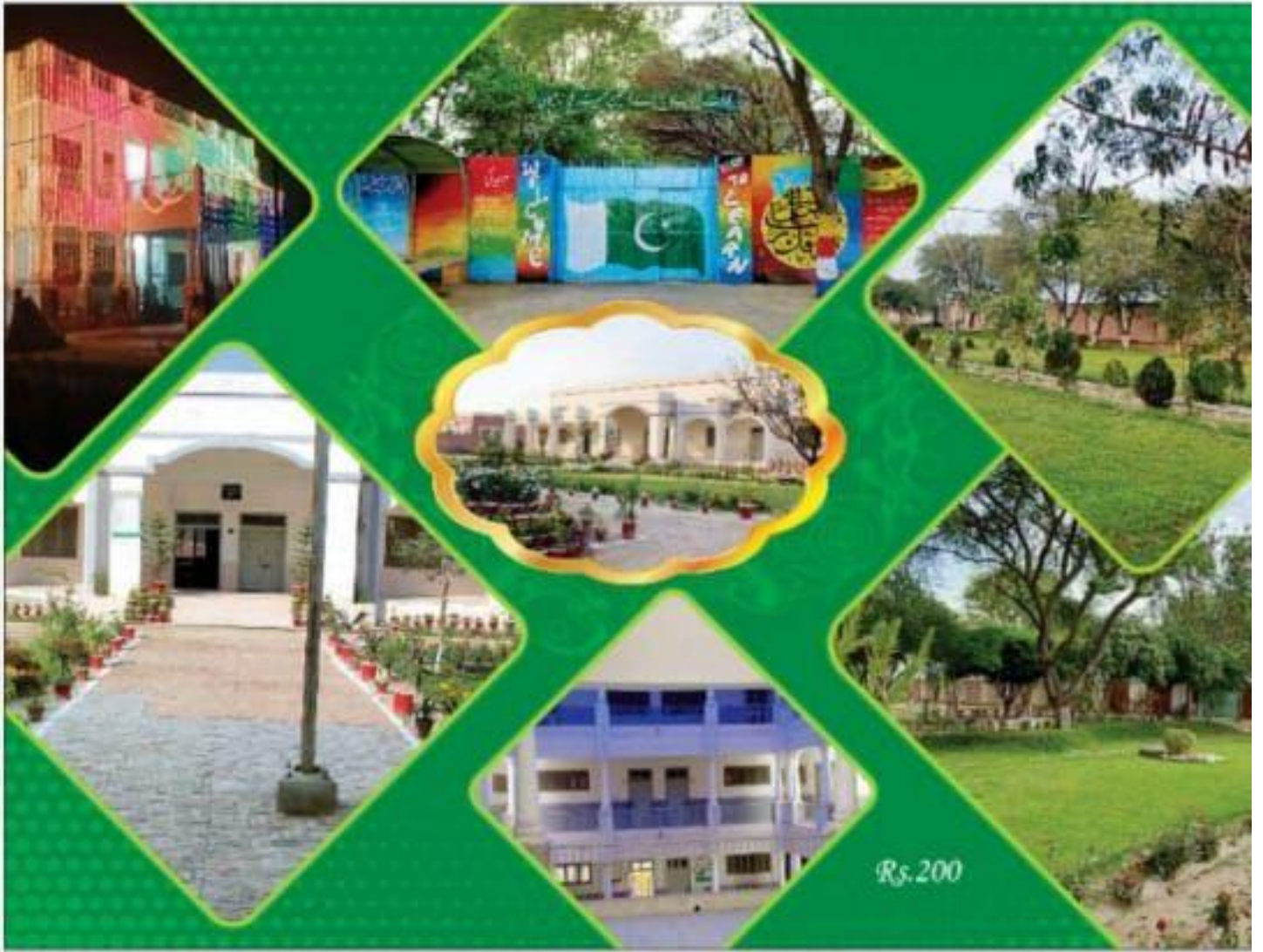
